Altogether, a very strong case can be made that while hominids such as the Neanderthal were native to this planet, modern humans could not have been and that an original human home world would have to meet a certain set of conditions and that, many thousands of years ago, Jupiter's largest moon, Ganymede, met all of those conditions.

As the cover to the book notes, we have not answered every question which people will have about human origins or solar system origins, but several of the questions we have answered are very big ones, particularly the question as to the first body in our system to be inhabited by modern humans.
